Staffing Update

Student Placements

Next Monday we also welcome 4th Year student teacher, Katie Walkingshaw to Meldrum. Katie will be working with Mrs Harvie in P2H for an 8 week period this term and next. Over the course of her placement she will be taking responsibility for class teaching and planning over a total of four school weeks.

Nursery Enrolment
