

PE Kit

This session we continue to teach PE both indoors and outdoors so please ensure your child has suitable indoor and outdoor gym kit in school at all times. It is helpful is all items are named. Please also remember that in the interest of safety jewellery, including earrings, should not be worn during PE lessons. Children unable to take out earrings by themselves should bring plasters, micro pore tape etc with them on PE days so that earrings can be taped over. Children with long hair should ensure that it is tied back during PE lessons to avoid any collisions or accidents.

Start of School Day

May we take this opportunity to remind parents of the importance of ensuring children arrive at school on time. This allows them to have the best start to the school day.

Early Stages Playground

A reminder that parents/carers are respectfully asked to leave the Early Stages Playground when the first bell rings at 9.13am. We also ask that parents stay clear of the gate area on Commercial Road to enable children to safely enter the playground.

School Car Park Safety

Our school car park remains a very busy place particularly at the beginning and end of the school day, and just ahead of the afternoon Nursery session. This session we continue to have a number of taxis dropping off and collecting children so please do not park in the dedicated disabled parking areas without good reason. We would also once again remind parents not to park in the dedicated bus parking bays, up on grass verges or on the access road leading from Provost Florence Drive to the school car park. Please be aware that the turning circle should be kept clear at all times. It has also been brought to our attention that a number of cars are stopping to drop off and pick up children on Meadowbank at the school gate causing a potential risk to children walking to and from school. Instead, please consider using the school car park.

Aberdeenshire Council Communication for Parents

Aberdeenshire Council has changed the way parents receive online alerts about school closures and changes to school transport. You can now sign up for these notifications through *myaccount* on the Aberdeenshire Council website – if you currently pay for school meals online, you will already be registered.

myaccount is a simple, secure way of accessing a range of Scottish public services using just one username and password and 13,000 parents across Aberdeenshire are already enjoying the benefits of it.

As well as being able to sign up for alerts, your home page will automatically give you handy information such as your bin collection days, where your nearest recycling centre is and the names of your local councillors.

So, if you want to be kept up-to-date and take advantage of the other *myaccount* benefits, sign up to the new system by going to the Aberdeenshire Council website and clicking on the red **register** button in the top right-hand corner.
