This Term's Learning

Literacy and English...

We will be learning about...

- Listening & Talking – This term the children will be bringing home an 'All About Me' bag to put items into, to help them share information about their experiences and interests.
- Writing – Magic Writing (Recording individual stories through drawings)
 - Black Line Drawings (Telling a story through detailed drawings)
- Phonics – Developing knowledge and understanding of rhyme, listening for sounds, orally blending sounds into words

Mathematics...

We will be learning about...

- Number – counting, sequencing, number formation, finding more/less and identifying the number before, between and after
- Shape – 2D and 3D shape

Across the Curriculum...

We will be learning about Autumn through the story of 'The Gigantic Turnip'. We will then move on to looking at 'Where we live'. In the coming weeks we would appreciate if the children could bring in a photograph of their own house.
