**Suggested Snow Day Activities**  
**P2/3H**



Here are some suggested activities to do whilst you are at home during any snow days this session. You do not have to complete all of the activities each day. Can you think of any extra activities?

### Suggested Activities

- Build a snowman.
  - P2 - measure it with your hands, a toy or a natural object e.g. stick/stone
  - P3 - measure with a ruler or tape measure.
- P2 Can you write the family of 6, 8, 12, and 15 in the snow e.g.  $0 + 8 = 8$ ,  $1 + 7 = 8$  etc. Can you write your numbers up to 100 in the snow?
- P3 - Write addition and subtraction sums in the snow e.g.  $48 + 9$ ,  $64 - 11$ . Write and order 10 numbers up to 1000.
- P2 - Write a snow sentence and draw a snow picture.
- P3 - Write a snow story with a picture.
- Put one cup of snow in the fridge, one cup of snow on the table and leave one cup of snow outside.
  - P2 Draw a picture of what happens.
  - P3 Write about what happens.
- Make a paper snowflake.
- Read your favourite story and write a different ending for it.
- Design a new book cover for it.
- Draw pictures or take photographs of a healthy snack
- If the weather gets really cold go outside and blow some bubbles as high up as you can, watch what happens to them.
