This Term's Learning

Literacy and English...

We will continue to learn sight vocabulary and common words. We shall be learning to spell using the sounds au, ew, ow(owl), ou, igh, y and magic e. We will continually revise all the sounds we have learned in P1 and P2. During Active Literacy tasks we will learn words with these sounds in them. In our story writing our focus will be using good vocabulary, punctuation, connectives and giving each story a beginning, a middle and an ending. Using our topic as a stimulus we will be writing imaginative stories, reports and poetry. We will learn and present a Scottish Poem for the Burns competition to develop our listening and talking skills.

Mathematics...

We will continue to recognise, count and order numbers to 100. Then work on our understanding of the concept of place value. We will work on developing mental strategies to add number to 10 and beyond. We will continue counting in 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s and 10s and identify odd and even numbers. We will be learning to recognise the coins to £2 and count amounts to £1. We will then be carrying out measuring activities. There will also be activities to help us learn about data handling and symmetry.

Across the Curriculum...

Rainforest - Maths – Creating bar charts. Butterfly and bug symmetry. Literacy – Writing 3 part stories, instructions, reports, poems. Reading rainforest books for information and pleasure. Creating an A – Z book. Expressive Arts – Using our artwork to create a classroom display. Sciences – four layers in a rainforest, compost, life cycles, water cycle, experiments with plants. Rainforest creatures. Health and Wellbeing – Rights and Responsibilities, Circle Times. Role of UNICEF, Technologies –Building a rain gauge. Social Studies – Why trees are important. People of the rainforest, endangered species, things we get from the rainforest.
