This Term's Learning

Literacy and English...

We look forward to hearing about the children's talking boxes in our Listening and Talking time. In our reading time we will learn to answer literal and inferential questions about texts. We will revise phonic sounds to consolidate our spelling skills, and learn new common words. In our writing we will focus on sentence structure and plan our writing using various formats. We will learn how to write leaflets.

Mathematics...

This term we will be consolidating mental agility using number facts within 20. We will be adding to 100 and learning about numbers to 100 and beyond. We will extend our knowledge of 2D and 3D shape. We will begin to look at measuring length and weight. We will learn some strategies to help us solve mathematical problems.

Across the Curriculum...

This term our **Topic** will be 'Our Community'. We will be learning about the history and geography of the local area, as well as looking at local businesses and services and how they meet our needs and wants. During **Health and Wellbeing** lessons we will be focusing on Feelings and Friendships. In **Science** we will be focusing our learning about materials. In **RME** we will learn about Christian beliefs about God.

Home Learning Arrangements

Home learning tasks will usually go home on a Monday and be due back in on a Thursday. Some home learning tasks, usually topic related, may have a longer time frame but this will be detailed in home learning jotters. Instructions will be stuck into home learning jotters. Please encourage your child to present their home learning as neatly as they can. Please sign completed homework. In addition to home learning tasks, reading will be sent home twice a week. Please support your child to practise their reading and sign their reading record once it is completed. Children should bring their reading books into school every day as there will be reading lessons or activities occurring every day.

Class Notes

PE Kits - Please ensure that your child has an indoor and outdoor kit. This will include shorts and indoor gym shoes along with warmer clothing and outdoor trainers. We will go outside as much as possible so please ensure that this kit is in school at all times. Please ensure all belongings are named.
