This Term's Learning

Literacy and English...

We will be learning about...

- Listening and Talking - Take part in a debate. Identify what 'cool talk' is and the impact of how we say something through our Being Cool In School, programme of work.
- Reading - Continue to have regular activities to develop fluency, comprehension and enjoyment.
- Spelling - Continue to have a regular spelling focus with class follow up activities.
- Writing - Create a variety of styles of poetry.
- Continue to consolidate the core writing skills of including the appropriate grammar, punctuation and structure.
- French- Learn the vocabulary for physical appearance and parts of the body.

Mathematics...

We will be learning about...

- Compass points, angles and planning journeys.
- Record lines of symmetry.
- Problem Solving – selecting and applying different strategies in a variety of contexts.

Across the Curriculum...

We will be learning about...

- Health and Wellbeing – Discuss the effects that some substances can have on our bodies.
- Complete our P6 Living and Growing unit. (More information to follow)
- Learn simple bandaging techniques in the Level 2 St John Ambulance First Aid Training.
- Technology - Use text, sounds and images to communicate information.
- Topic - There will be a science focus including looking at body systems.
- Science – Investigating sound and light energy.
