This Term's Learning

Literacy and English...

We will be learning about...

- Listening and Talking focus on actively listening and valuing others contributions during group discussion. We will be listening to a class novel.
- Through regular reading sessions we will cover a wide range of skills through book detective activities which will further develop comprehension, fluency and enjoyment.
- Writing by linking our writing experiences to our topic to give interesting contexts. The core writing skills of spelling, grammar, punctuation and presentation will be a continued focus.

Mathematics...

We will be learning about...

- Problem Solving selecting and applying different strategies in a variety of contexts.
- Information Handling to gather, collate and present data in a range of formats.
- Shape To identify the properties of 3D shapes.
- Number Place Value and Addition. Focussing on both mental and written strategies.

Across the Curriculum...

We will be learning about...

- Health & Wellbeing P6 will develop their co-operative learning skills.
- P6 will explore and respond to music from the WW2 era.
- Through our topic we will create a variety of artwork inspired by our research on WW2.
- Social Studies We will learn about why people and events from a particular time in the past were important and the impact WW2 had on people's lives, past and present.

Home Learning Arrangements
