This Term's Learning

Literacy and English...

We will be learning about...

- Listening and Talking – identify what 'cool talk' is and consider the impact of how we say something through our Cool in School work.
- Spelling by having a regular spelling focus with linked class follow up activities.
- Reading - regular activities to develop fluency, expression and understanding of different texts.
- Writing we will be focusing on writing an imaginative story for a younger audience for the Stuart Gray Award and look at a different types of poetry
- Continue to consolidate the use of core writing skills, grammar, punctuation and structure.

Mathematics...

We will be learning about...

- Position and Movement – Compass points, angles and planning journeys
- Time - reading 12/24 hour time, as well as converting between these
- Money – compare prices of goods from a variety of sources and work to a budget
- Problem Solving - identifying, selecting and applying appropriate strategies in a variety of contexts.

Across the Curriculum...

We will be learning about...

- Health and Wellbeing - Cool in School programme and Alcohol Focus – discuss effects that some substances can have on our bodies.
- We will also complete our P6 Living and Growing unit (more information to follow)
- Learn simple bandaging techniques in the Level 2 St John Ambulance First Aid Training.
- Science – forces and energy
- PE - athletics
- Topic – Movie Magic. We will be investigating the different careers and roles in the film and theatre business, taking a look at the history of the industry and analysing how productions are created using different methods.

Home Learning Arrangements

Home Learning will usually be issued on a Monday and be due in on Fridays. Children will record any changes to these arrangements in their school diaries. Home Learning will reflect on going class work and national events and will be explained fully when issued.
