**This Term's Learning**

**Literacy and English...**

We will be learning about...

- Listening and Talking - Focusing on valuing others' contributions and developing confidence when sharing personal ideas and opinions.
- Reading - With regular activities to develop fluency, comprehension and enjoyment.
- Spelling - A spelling focus with linked class follow up activities.
- Writing - With a focus on the features of journalistic and persuasive writing and continuing to consolidate the core writing skills of including the appropriate grammar, punctuation and structure.

**Mathematics...**

We will be learning about...

- Information Handling - Gathering, displaying and interpreting data in a variety of ways.
- Problem Solving - Identifying, selecting and applying appropriate strategies.
- Number – Identifying place value and carrying out addition using mental strategies and the standard written method.

**Across the Curriculum...**

We will be learning about...

- Health & Wellbeing - Develop co-operative learning skills and explore a range of group roles.
- Social Studies - Learn about why people and events from a particular time in the past were important and the impact WW2 had on people's lives, past and present.

**Home Learning Arrangements**
