This Term's Learning

Our topic this term is Enterprise/Chinese New Year. We will be finding out about Chinese New Year and how it is celebrated. We will learn about the year of the tiger and the other animals that make up the stories of Chinese New Year. We have lots of great crafts planned including masks, lanterns and a large dragon! We are hoping to cook some Chinese food and learn some phrases. We are presenting our topic work to the whole school during our assembly.

In Literacy, we are continuing to learn new sounds and the children are making great progress recognising their sounds and blending them to make words. This term children will have reading in class every week. To prepare for our Scottish Poetry competition in February, children will be given a poem home to learn which we will also be practising in class.
