This Term's Learning

We have an exciting term of learning ahead of us! Our topic this term is Transport. We will be looking at lots of different types of transport and how they operate and work. There will be lots of chance for art and science during this topic which I know the children will love!

In maths and numeracy we will be continuing our work on addition and subtraction as well as looking at ordering and sequencing to 100. We will be delving more into fractions, time and data handling too and start looking at more problem solving work to challenge the students.

In literacy, there will be a big focus on writing. This will be handwriting as well as word and sentence building. We will continue to look at new digraphs in phonics whilst also recapping our previous sounds too. We will use this phonics knowledge to build our knowledge of VCOP (vocabulary, connectives, openers and punctuation!) The children love creating stories, so a focus on sequencing stories and adding as much detail will be at the forefront. The children will also continue their amazing progress with reading through challenging narrative and non-fiction stories.

We will continue to look at relationships at home and within the classroom and how our actions can impact these relationships. This will also include looking further at emotions and also how we can build our and others resilience in tricky situations. PE will be focusing on ball games, the first of which will be tennis. There will also be a continued focus on sharing which will display itself during our lessons as well as play too.

The children love their music lessons, so we will continue exploring songs and instruments to find out more about how they have come about through looking at different genres. We will continue to explore different general knowledge topics through Mystery Doug and learn about the world around us.
