**This Term's Learning**

This term in Numeracy and Marths, we will be developing our understanding of Multiplication and Division. We will continue to explore the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, investigate position and movement in shape and calculate the area and perimeter of more complex shapes.

In Literacy this term we will focus on Scots Poetry which will include learning and reciting Scottish poems. We will celebrate World Book Day by sharing our favourite authors and books. In Reading we will continue to use regular activities to develop our fluency, comprehension and enjoyment. We will take part in the Stuart Gray writing competition by creating an imaginative Scots short story.

In Health and Wellbeing we will focus on the next units of our BounceBack scheme: 'Looking on the Brightside', 'Emotions' and 'Relationships'. For RSHP we will learn about physical and emotional changes in the human body during puberty. In PE we will learn about the skills involved in net games and invasion games.

Our Topic this term will be Scotland and Europe's Waters. This is a geography based topic and will focus on extending our mental map and our sense of place. It will also include a science element.
