This Term's Learning

Numeracy and Maths

Money: Building on our knowledge of place value by calculating change, comparing costs and beginning to consider the importance of budgeting.

Multiplication: Building speed and accuracy in multiplication tables and applying this to calculations.

Measurement: Using appropriate units of measurement, read a variety of scales, calculate perimeter.

Literacy

Listening and Talking: Exploring Scots language through a variety of learning activities.

Reading: Developing our skills in written comprehension to show understanding of a range of texts.

Through discussion and written activities, identify the techniques used by authors.

Writing: Building on our skills in imaginative writing by creating effective setting, character and plot.

Identifying features of persuasive writing and beginning to use them in our own writing.

Digital Literacy: Continuing to use a variety of resources to develop keyboard skills. We will be using iMovie to share our learning.
