This Term's Learning

Our class novel this term is 'Letters From The Lighthouse' by Emma Carroll. This novel links well with our topic which is WW2. We will also be doing a country study and have chosen Japan.

The class will continue with our library visits, this will be on a Monday morning. We encourage children to take books in from home to read during our ERIC time (Everyone Reads In Class), please ensure they have their name on them to avoid them getting lost.

In maths pupils will continue to work on number and problem solving using the 4 functions, addition, multiplication, division and subtraction. P7B will be learning about the properties of 2D and 3D shape this term with Mrs Reid and developing their knowledge and understanding of fractions with Mrs Cooper.

As part of our learning through Developing The Young Workforce, this term we have visitors from Skills Development Scotland. The children will take part in activities to help them develop their understanding around future careers.

In Health and Wellbeing the children will be discussing and developing their understanding around substance abuse. We will continue our RSHP learning (Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenthood). As a class we continue to work through the Second Level topics.
