This Term's Learning

Our topic this term is Machines and Magnets. Within this, we will learn about different types of transport.

Literacy: Listening and Talking: We will continue to have regular opportunities to discuss our feelings and emotions. We will also share our opinions about what we have watched or read. This term, in addition to our normal Doric poetry competition we will be learning a Scots story, The Three Wee Pigs. The children will be asked to recite the poem to the class or the class teacher if they prefer.

Reading: We will focus on sequencing events in the correct order. We will identify nouns, verbs and adjectives in the text. We will answer simple questions about what we have read.

Writing: Children will write their own version of 'The Three Wee Pigs' and will be encouraged to include Scots and Doric words in their writing. We will be starting 'Free Writing Fridays' where the children can write about their own experiences and create imaginative stories using pictures and words.

Numeracy: We will continue to read and write numbers to 100. Children will practise place value within 100, as well as estimating and rounding. We will continue to reinforce our basic addition and subtraction facts within 10 and 20. We will learn how to record o'clock and half past times. We will use technology and play to follow directions e.g. forwards, backwards, right and left. We will estimate, and measure, length, weight and capacity.

Health and Wellbeing: Our Bounce Back topics will be, Looking on the Bright Side, Emotions and Relationships. In RSHP we will learn about similarity, diversity and respect.

PE: In outdoor PE we will be focusing on Invasions Games, beginning with Touch Rugby. In indoor PE we will begin with Target Games, such as Boccia and move onto Net Games, such as Tennis.

French: We continue to use French on a daily basis for instructions, greetings, numbers and colours.

Music and Drama - We will use puppets to act out the story of 'The Three Wee Pigs'. We will learn Scottish songs and rhymes such as Heid, Shooters, Knaps and Taes.

Art: We will use our imagination to solve real life design problems, We will discuss our thoughts and feelings about the work of selected Scottish artists. We will use their work as stimulus for our own.
