Literacy

Listening and Talking- As part of our celebrations for Burns we will be learning and reciting Scots poetry. Children will have the opportunity to take part in the Scots poetry competition at the end of January.

Reading- We will use continue to use regular activities to develop fluency, understanding and enjoyment. We will have a library session on a Monday and children will have new reading on a Monday/Thursday for some groups and Tuesday/ Friday for others.

Writing- This term our writing focus will be imaginative writing.

Spelling- We will introducing some new spelling sounds and be consolidating ones that have already been taught as well as building up our bank of common words.

Numeracy- This term we will be looking at time. In number we will be continuing to look at subtraction before moving on to look at multiplication.

Health and Wellbeing- In our RSHP this term we will be will focusing on similarities, diversities and respect. Through Bounceback we will continue to talk about and share strategies to help deal with negative situations and how our emotions can be impacted.

PE - In our outdoor PE we will be trying different ball games and in our indoor PE sessions we will be doing gymnastics.

Topic- Our topic this term will be Farming. Later on this term we will look forward to a visit from the Royal Northern Countryside Initiative and we are hoping they will bring some special visitors along with them.
