*NUMERACY:

- Investigating square and cube numbers, factors, multiples and prime numbers

- Division - using written methods to divide a 4 digit number by a single digit, and for some, long division.

- Time-converting between 12 and 24 hr times, calculating journey times and investigating the links between speed, distance and time.

- Area and Perimeter- calculate area and perimeter of a variety of shapes, including rectangles and triangles.

*LITERACY:

Class Novel - There's a boy in the girl's bathroom. We will be discussing and responding to the story and showing our understanding through a variety of comprehension tasks.

Writing - Focus on Scots Language. We will be looking closely at a few Scottish Poems and translating well known stories into Scots. We will continue to develop our knowledge of story structure through imaginative writing (suspense) and also be creating our own reports.

RSHP - Parenting - learning about the skills and qualities required to be a parent/carer.
