Myself and Mrs Holland will be out in Early Stages and Meadowbank Playgrounds from 9.05am each morning. There will be no before school supervision in the Main Playground. All children should arrive as close to 9.15am as possible.

School Uniform

Children from P1-7 are expected to wear school uniform. The recommended school uniform is dark grey trousers/skirt/shorts, white shirt/polo shirt and red sweatshirt/jumper/cardigan. We will return to pre-Covid arrangements of children changing for gym. Gym kit consists of shorts, T-shirt and gym shoes or trainers. It is helpful for your child's gym kit to be in a small bag which can hang on their peg. It should remain in school all week in case of changes to PE times. Children may also be learning outdoors or have PE outside at various points during the week, so it is helpful if they are wearing school shoes which are suitable for this purpose. Each year, we collect a huge amount of unnamed lost property in school. Please name everything!

In the current financial climate, we understand that many families may need support with acquiring school uniform and/or gym kit. Help is available through the school and the local community so please get in touch if you need support with this.

School Bags

During Covid, many children grew accustomed to not bringing a school bag to school. This session, children can continue to choose whether or not they would like to bring a bag to school, either option is fine. Pencil cases are also optional. Children should bring a water bottle containing water (not juice please) to school each day.

Car Park

A reminder to please use the school car park in a safe and courteous manner. Please do not park on the grass verges, stick strictly to the 10mph speed limit and do not park in the disabled parking bays unless you are entitled to do so.
