
Home Learning

After taking a break from Home Learning last term, this has begun again this week. All Home Learning will be shared and should be submitted using Google Classroom. Home Learning will be issued on Wednesdays and should be handed in the following Wednesday. Each week, a Literacy task and Numeracy task will be set and each term, there will be an additional task which may span several weeks. All tasks will support your child's learning in school. A jotter will be provided for all children to use if required - this should remain at home and does not need to be returned to school. When completing tasks, please submit evidence of the task so teachers can see what your child has achieved.

Please support your children to complete their home learning tasks each week. Home learning is an important part of your child's educational journey and a valuable way of your child sharing their learning with you. If we can support in any way, please get in touch.

To Access Activities in Google Classroom

- 1. Log on to Glow https://sts.platform.rmunify.com/Account/SignIn/glow
- 2. Click the Meldrum School launch pad on the left hand side



3. Click the Google Classroom tile





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4. Click your child's class tile

5. The work set will appear in the classwork tab at the top.

Depending on the type of task, you can submit a typed

document, file or photo to share the learning. To submit
click on the assignment, in the top right corner 'Your Work' box click 'Add or Create'

and you can create a Google Doc (which you can type in and send to the teacher) or

upload a file you've created already and saved on your device (file, photo etc).

Car Parking

I am increasingly concerned about the unsafe parking in our car park. Parking on the grass verges and corners is very unsafe and is going to lead to an accident or someone being injured. Robertson Facilities Management, the company who run our building, have also expressed their concern about this and are taking steps to prevent it. Additional areas have been planted and some additional signage is to be put up. We are in the fortunate position of being able to offer some visitor and parent/carer parking in our car park so I ask again that parents/carers use the designated bays for parking and do not park in the bus bay, disabled parking spaces or the turning circle. If the car park is full, please park elsewhere.
