Cycle Safety

It is great to see so many pupils cycling and scooting to school. However, we have had instances where pupils have been cycling/scooting unsafely in the playground and car park when they arrive on the school grounds. If your child cycles/scoots to school, please remind them that, when they arrive on school grounds, they should safely come off of their bike/scooter and walk it to the bike racks. They should then promptly secure their bike/scooter and make their way to their lines. There are a number of children, cars and adults accessing the school grounds in the morning and we need to avoid congestion around the bike racks in order to keep everyone safe.

Parking Near to School

We have had communication about parents parking on double yellow lines in Westbank Park in the mornings. Please do not park on double yellow lines as this is potentially dangerous for families walking this route to school. I appreciate your support to keep everyone safe at morning drop off time.

Basics Bank

Meldrum Academy have a basics bank available for the community to access. Please see information below.

We are aware of the increasing pressure on many families with the financial impact of the current situation, please think about using our Basics Bank if this can play a small part to help. This confidential service is available to anyone within the Meldrum cluster.

We want to ensure the most basic of personal care items are available to every young person at Meldrum Academy and the Cluster Primaries.

The Basics Bank, will be made accessible in a safe and confidential manner and young people and their families, will be able to access items such as shampoo, conditioner, shower gels and deodorants, toothpastes and toothbrushes, sanitary products, washing powder, cleaning wipes,



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washing liquid and more, as they need them. Without the fear of being judged or others knowing.

These will be available to collect during school hours from the Basics Bank cupboard at the academy (next to the library, just off the school reception) Pupils can pop in anytime to help themselves or if any parent/carer would like to access it please pop into the Academy.

Free School Meals for Primary 6 and Primary 7 pupils


The Scottish Government has paused the roll out of free school meals to all Primary 6 and Primary 7 pupils. The government's decision was made to allow further work with COSLA, the national association of Scottish councils, and all local authorities to fully assess the financial and infrastructure challenges that have been highlighted for the final phase of the expansion plans. We will be in touch with further information when a decision is taken by the government to progress the roll-out to all Primary 6 and Primary 7 pupils.

How do I login?




- 1. The school will have sent you a website address to login with.
- 2. Next, login by completing the requested fields



Dashboard






Suggest Bookings for Me



Suggest Bookings for Me will let you choose the teachers you want to book (across multiple students, if applicable), and asks when you are available for appointments.

The system then calculates the most efficient order for your appointments, and you have 5mins to confirm (or adjust) these.



Make Bookings for Myself



To pick appointment times for yourself, or to edit your appointments, use Make Bookings for Myself.

- 1. Select the correct subject
- 2. Select the correct teacher
- 3. Click on Book to make an appointment

Simply repeat the process for each appointment you would like to make. You can also 'Modify' appointments you have made.

Once bookings have all been made you can print or e-mail an appointment confirmation.
