Staffing

Children in Need

Pupil Voice and Participation

Pupil Voice is a chance for all our children and young people to have the opportunity to participate, lead and play a role in decisions which affect the school and their learning. We have refreshed our approach to Pupil Voice and participation in order that all children can take part in different ways. Each Monday afternoon, on a three weekly rotation, children will take part in Assembly, Pupil Voice and OTTER Clubs.

<u>Junior Leadership Team</u> The JLT will meet regularly to discuss school improvements and issues which are important to the children. Each class from Nursery – P7 will be represented on our Junior Leadership Team by a class representative who will share the views of their class.

<u>House Captains</u> All our P7s have become House Captains for our four houses; Chrystal, Forsyth, Keith and Manson. Their focus will be to promote positive relationships across the school by being good role models and leading by example. They will also work alongside their teacher and the Senior Leadership Team to plan House Events for all children in their House to take part in.

<u>Eco Schools Group</u> Our P6 children will lead the work of our Eco Group as children across the school work together during Pupil Voice Time as we strive to achieve our Eco Schools Green Flag.

OTTER Clubs OTTER stands for Our Time Together Enhancing Relationships and classes will team up with another class to work collaboratively to learn new skills and build relationships with children in another part of the school.

<u>Assembly</u> During the year, each year group will have an opportunity to plan and lead an assembly, sharing their learning and achievements with their peers. Our Pupil Voice groups will also lead assemblies linked to their work.

Additional Support for Learning

We are very lucky at Meldrum School to have Pupil Support Assistants and Additional Support for Learning Teachers who provide additional support for children in school. Support is provided to children for a variety of reasons – educational support, emotional support, social support and takes a variety of forms – individual, small group, whole class – depending on the

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specific needs of the children involved. During their school career, almost all children will receive support in their learning from one of team. If you would like any additional information about any support your child is receiving, please speak to their class teacher in the first instance.

The Basics Bank will be made accessible in a safe and confidential manner to young people and their families, without the fear of being judged or others knowing. This service can be accessed as often as you need it. You will be able to access items such as shampoo, conditioner, shower gels and deodorants, toothpastes and toothbrushes and sanitary products. We also have kitchen/bathroom items, such as washing powder and cleaning products.
