This Term's Learning

Our Topics this term will be Machines with a technology focus and Magnets with a science focus. We will investigate how technology helps us and design a magnetic game.

Listening and Talking - We will continue to share our opinions about what we have watched or read and explore texts in local dialects.

Reading - We will continue group reading with a focus on sequencing events in the correct order. We will identify nouns, verbs and adjectives in the text and answer simple questions about what we have read.

Writing - Children will continue to be encouraged to check their written work includes the correct use of capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and that the letters have been formed correctly. We will be focusing on the use of joining words to make sentences longer.

Numeracy - We will continue to read and write numbers to 100. Children will practise saying the number names from 0-100 forwards and backwards. We will use cubes and other materials to make numbers to 100. We will also continue to practise different ways to add and subtract numbers within 10, 20 and in some cases beyond.

Maths - We will be reading and recording time in whole and half hours and we will be identifying and naming all coins to a value of £5.

PE - will consist of Football and Gymnastics, as well as building our flexibility through yoga stretches.

Art - We will learn how to use pen and line to add detail to images.

Music - We will sing and create music with a Scottish focus.

Health and Wellbeing - We will explore the topics of 'Looking on the Bright Side', 'Emotions' and 'Relationships' through our BounceBack programme.

RME - We will learn about the festivals of Easter and Holi

French - We will continue to use French on a daily basis to learn greetings, numbers and colours.
