This Term's Learning

Topic - Our first topic this term will follow on from our learning about Scottish Culture and will focus on our local area of Oldmeldrum.

Literacy - Listening and Talking - We will listen to and recite some scottish poetry and celebrate Scots language.

Reading - We will continue to develop fluency, understanding and enjoyment through our group reading, paying particular attention to punctuation. Further details can be found inside each pupil's reading record.

Writing - We will consolidate basic sentence structure across all areas of written work. We will experiment with different connectives to extend our sentences and make our writing more exciting. We will continue to have regular opportunities to practise correct letter formations and attempt simple joins. Spelling - We will revise spelling patterns and learn common spelling rules. As always, we will encourage pupils to transfer learned spelling into all areas of our work.

Numeracy - We will continue to develop our sense of whole number and place value. We will begin to look at fractions with a focus on the role of the denominator. We will be investigating addition, repeated addition and how this links to mulitplication. In maths we will be learning how to tell the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to the next hour using both analogue and digital clocks. We will continue to practise ordering the months of the year, seasons and days of the week.

HWB - Our Bounce Back theme this term is 'Emotions'. We will identify different emotions and discuss how we can mange them. In P.E we will develop our control, balance and co-ordination when performing a range of movements and gymnastic skills. We also have the opportunity to participate in several P.E workshops led by NESCOL students.
